
CLUB REGULATIONS

General

- Launch will leave dock 15 minutes before mealtimes or closing for final run unless continuous service is provided.
- Members are to respect Steward's hours.
- Launch call: one long, 2 short blasts (Morse "D". Radio: Channel 78. Supplemental call: "T flag" (Tango). Please relay launch calls. Don't make calls during non-service periods.
- **ONLY DULY QUALIFIED PERSONS, WHO ARE AUTHORIZED BY THE FLEET CAPTAIN, MAY OPERATE THE LAUNCHES.**
- Observe posted launch capacities.
- Tipping is not expected for regular service.
- The Club shall in no instance be responsible for any personal injury or property damage occurring aboard launches or caused by launches.
- Without specific instructions, launch operators are not authorized to deliver guests to any Member's yacht in the absence of the Member or person in the Member's immediate family.
- A Member may not extend the use of the Club facilities, including launch service, to unaccompanied guests on more than any six days during the yearly period the Club is in Commission.
- All children 14 years old and under must wear PFD on pier, dock and launches.

Parking Lot

- Only for cars displaying Club identification; unauthorized cars may be towed away at owner's expense.
- One car per family in lot.

Dock & Floats

- Deep draft boats have preference at high tides.
 - Do not tie up for more than 20 minutes on Fridays, weekends and holidays.
 - Do not tie up overnight.
 - Keep dock and floats clear of loose gear.
 - **STOW ALL DINGHIES BOTTOM UP IN RACKS**, or provide storm cover.
 - Dinghies must be removed from the Club by November 1st.
 - Dinghy racks and moorings are limited and are obtained from the Fleet Captain at a cost set annually by the Board of Trustees.
 - Informal "reservations" for beaching area are forfeited if yacht has not approached the dock by one hour after high water.

Clubhouse

- Do not store gear or dinghies in clubhouse. The Club is not responsible for any member's property stored in any part of the Club.
- Steward's shop and living quarters are private. Don't intrude.
- Rental of Clubhouse for daytime and evening functions is available. Contact Mary Lu Dempsey for arrangements: (516) 767-1760.

Moorings & Mooring Area:

- Club winterizes moorings and installs members' pick-up pendants and chain through buoys in the spring.
- The Town of North Hempstead, having designated our anchorage as a special anchorage area for the use of the Club's members, the anchorage, moorings, and all boats therein shall be under the supervision and control of the Fleet Captain and the Club's Ground Tackle and Mooring Committee.
- Members shall comply with all Federal, State, and Local regulations regarding our anchorage.
- Mooring positions and numbers in our anchorage shall be assigned by the Fleet Captain.
- All parts of ground tackle mooring and its make-up must be furnished or contracted for by member, and are subject to approval by the Ground Tackle and Mooring Committee.
- Ground tackle is spotted, removed, or lifted for inspection and repair at owner's expense every three years. The Fleet Captain may require inspection and repair or replacement of ground tackle at other intervals.
- Club is not responsible for removal, transfer, or sale of moorings. Moorings owned by those whose Club membership has terminated shall be removed within 6 months of termination; otherwise, ownership of the mooring shall be deemed vested in the Club.
- The Club shall in no instance be responsible for any moorings or any injury or damage that may occur in the mooring area, or result from any failure of a mooring or its gear, in whole or in part.
- Guest mooring fees are established by the Board of Trustees.

Club Devices

- Club burgees and cap buttons may be obtained from the Steward.
